Scholarship Criteria

- ◆ Each applicant is required to submit a completed application.
- ◆ Submit a copy of his or her most recent High School or College transcript and a registered application proving his or her acceptance to a college.
- ◆ Applicants could be a freshman, sophomore, junior or senior attending college.
- ◆ Applicants must have a C or better average in High School or College.
- ◆ Applicants must submit an essay of not less than 150 words stating how the scholarship would assist them in reaching their short or long time goals.
